Elohim - אֱלֹהִים (H430)

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

“Elo-heem”

The plural of Eloah (H433)– אֱלֹהִים

Shortened to El אֵל (H410) in other compound names

Translated mostly God or god

Deuteronomy 10:17 For the LORD your God *is* God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward:

- א – What is first, strength
- ל – Teach, learn, staff
- ה – Behold
- י – Hand, finished work
- ם – Mighty, water

God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
אֱלֹהֵי אַבְרָהָם יִצְחָק וְיַעֲקֹב
Elohe Abraham, Yitzhak v'Yaakob

El Shaddai - אֵל שַׁדַּי (H7706)

Genesis 17:1 And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I *am* the Almighty (H7706) God (H410); walk before me, and be thou perfect.

“El Shad-ah-ee”

Almighty God

Possibly from “shode” שָׁדַד (H7701) (Spoil or destruction)

- א – What is first, strength
- ל – Teach, learn
- ש – Teeth, point of rock, sharp, consume, destroy
- ד – door, pathway
- י – Hand, finished work

El Elyon - אֵל עֲלִיּוֹן (H5945)

Genesis 14:18 And Melchizedek...priest of the most high (H5945) God (H410) .

El (H410) Elyon (H5945) – Most High God

From Alaw אֶלְוָה (H5927) elevation, supreme

- ע – Eye, look, see, appear
- ל – Teach, learn
- י – Hand, finished work
- ו – Nail, hook, joining together, making secure
- נ – Fish, life, to spread, heir to the throne
